

## **This is an after action report on the RCACN Eastern Regional Battleday at Danville June 2005**

The Battleday was scheduled for June 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup>, & 5<sup>th</sup> (Friday, Saturday, & Sunday).

We had about 5 people show up on Thursday by the end of Friday we had about 21 and by the end of Saturday we had 24 registered participants (R/C tankers).

Saturday had many structured Battles along Axis verses Allied lines and the historical competition battles.

Note: Most all of the tanks are from Tamiya or based on Tamiya tanks. Some are based on Trumpeter static T-34, WSN R/C T-34, or scratch built AFVs. But all are combat capable with the Tamiya Battle Units so all have the Tamiya electronics inside- DMD & MF units and use the Tamiya Battle Unit. It should also be noted that this is the first time that about half of all tanks from the Allied and Axis are non-base model Tamiya kits but conversions of some sort. Also of note is the growing contingent of T-34 tanks
